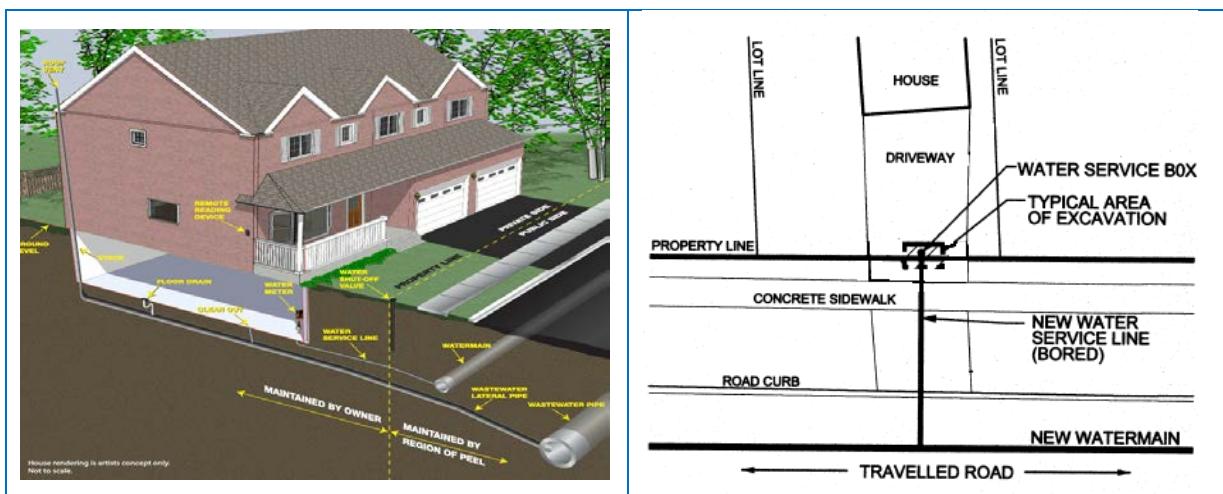

PROJECT UPDATE
WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT
ONEIDA CRESCENT, ONEIDA COURT AND SIR RICHARDS ROAD
CITY OF MISSISSAUGA

Update

- The new watermain on Oneida Crescent, Oneida Court and Sir Richards Road have now been installed. The next phase is to commission the watermain and put them into service. Properties on these streets will now have their individual water lines transferred from the old watermain to the new watermain.
- A new water service line will be brought up to the property line where a new water service box will also be installed. Where possible your water line will be brought up to the property line using trenchless methods. However, **the area around the water service box will be excavated.**

When?

- We expect to start work on or about Thursday, April 27, 2017, starting on Oneida Crescent south of Queensway West.
- The project should be completed before August 31, 2017. All work is under warranty for two years from the completion date.
- We will start restoring the road and boulevard when all water system replacements and transfers are complete, and as weather permits.

Working Hours

- Our contractor's normal working hours are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. These hours are consistent with the local municipality's bylaws. We understand this may cause some inconvenience, but a shorter working day would mean the project would take longer to complete.

Interrupting Your Water Supply

- It is our goal to let you know 48 hours (2 days) in advance if we need to shut off your water. Occasionally, we may have to reduce this notice to 24 hours.
- If we have to shut off your water because of an emergency, we will do everything we can to fix the problem as quickly as possible.

- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
