

## Environmental Assessment Study

### Notice of Public Information Centre 2 Mississauga Sewage Pumping Stations Upgrades – Silver Birch Trail Sewage Pumping Station

The Region of Peel has identified the need to upgrade the Silver Birch Trail Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) as shown on the map due to its aging infrastructure. An Environmental Assessment (EA) study is underway to determine the best solution for the required upgrades.

The first Public Information Centre (PIC) held on April 19, 2017, for the Silver Birch Trail SPS, Rosemere Road SPS and Indian Road SPS presented background information, alternatives evaluation, conceptual designs and proposed construction impact reduction measures.

The project team agreed that a second PIC was needed based on comments received and additional options that needed to be considered. Additionally, the report for the Silver Birch Trail SPS will be filed separately from the Rosemere Road and Indian Road SPS.

#### Public Information Centre 2

A second Public Information Centre (PIC 2) is being held to address the comments received at PIC 1. A revised conceptual design, proposed construction activities, construction impact reduction measures and next steps for the Silver Birch SPS will be presented. It will be held on:

PIC 2 will be an informal drop-in session where attendees can review project information and ask questions.

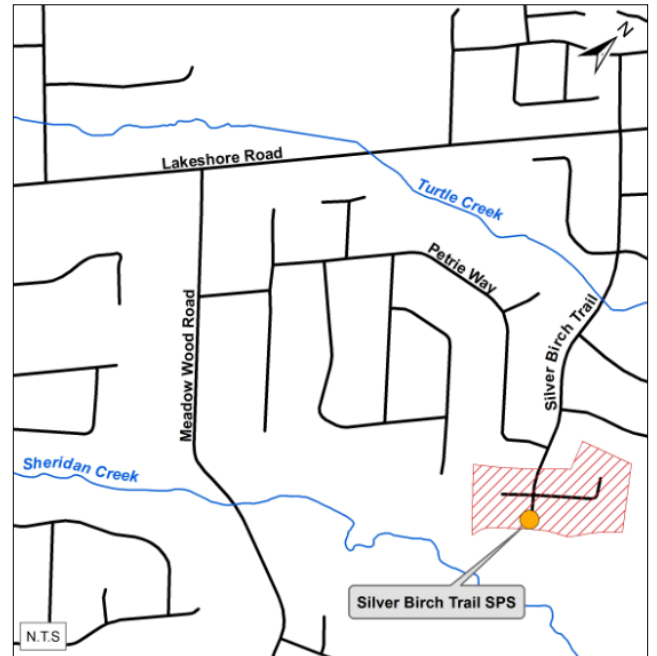
