 - g. existing or planned capacity of infrastructure and services such as water and wastewater, street network, community amenities, and multi-modal transportation systems is sufficient; and
 - h. phasing of development is in accordance with the timing and delivery of infrastructure and services such as water and wastewater and transit infrastructure, including, but not limited to, distribution, connections, capacity,
