Recent Updates to Environmental Related Focus Area Policies

Based on comments received from residents and stakeholders during the March 2020 consultations, staff continue to review draft policies and mapping for possible refinements and updates. In some instances, the draft environment related focus area policies in the Regional Official Plan have been updated with new wording to make them clearer or more direct.

In some instances, comments that were received have generated the need for strengthened policies. Regional staff continue to work and consult with Provincial staff, local partners, stakeholders, agencies and the public to finalize these draft policies as part of the Peel 2041 process.
