PROJECT UPDATE

WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT ON BRUCE BEER DRIVE, CAMBERLEY CRESCENT AND ASHURST CRESCENT CITY OF BRAMPTON

What are we doing?

- Permanent asphalt restoration at the intersection of Bruce Beer Drive and Rutherford Road.
- Permanent asphalt restoration of road and driveways on Camberley Crescent.
- Clean-up, boulevard restoration, concrete restoration, road and asphalt restoration on Ashurst Crescent following watermain replacement.
- Rectifying settlements and deficiencies on Bruce Beer Drive and Camberley Crescent.

Why?

- To finish restoration following upgrades of the water distribution system.

When?

- We expect to start work on or about Monday May 14, 2018 at the intersection of Bruce Beer Drive and Rutherford Road, weather permitting.
- Rectifying settlements and deficiencies on Bruce Beer Drive and Camberley Crescent may commence before the above date.

Traffic and Parking Control

- We may need to reduce traffic to a single lane during construction.

Driveway Access

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.

- Please call the Project Manager if you have special needs related to access or business hours.

Replacing and Taking Care of Your Sod

- We will place topsoil and sod in disturbed areas from the watermain upgrades based upon availability. Settlements over the winter months will be filled in with new topsoil as well.
- The contractor will take care of any sod we replace for 30 days
- You can help the sod to stay healthy by watering it for one hour in the early morning, two or three times a week. This is especially important in hot or dry weather.

Repairing Your Driveway

- If we have marked or cut your driveway, we will repair the asphalt in the disturbed area as marked on your driveway. Unfortunately, the Region **cannot** completely replace your driveway. **Please review the marks on your driveway.**
- **The temporary driveway asphalt placed in 2017 on Camberley Crescent shall be removed and replaced with permanent driveway asphalt at this time.**
- We will repair your driveway as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.
- **If you would like to have the rest of your driveway paved at this time, please contact either the contractor or the paving subcontractor named on the front of this letter. These are the only two contacts for you. Please do not accept direct solicitation from any contractor telling you that they have been retained by the Region. Please remember this is your option. If you choose to do nothing, we will repair all areas damaged by our construction; however, we are unable to completely replace your driveway.**
- **If your driveway was impacted by watermain construction on Bruce Beer Drive, it will be restored to property line as part of the City of Brampton's road resurfacing program, anticipated in 2019, subject to budget and Council approval. If you are planning to have your driveway paved, you are encouraged to wait until the City of Brampton's road resurfacing program commences in order to avoid any cuts or patches that may be required on your driveway during the work.**

Repairing the Road, Curb, and Sidewalks

- All sections of curbs and sidewalks impacted by watermain construction shall be replaced on Camberley Crescent.
- The impacted roadway on Camberley Crescent will be restored with new asphalt over the watermain trench width only.

Project Updates

- The Region of Peel will always let you know if there are any major changes to the plans.
- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
- Please call the project manager or inspector if you have any problems or special needs.
