PROJECT UPDATE WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT ON CAMBERLEY CRESCENT CITY OF BRAMPTON

What are we doing?

- Clean-up, boulevard restoration, concrete restoration, road and asphalt restoration on Camberley Crescent following watermain replacement.

Why?

- To finish restoration following upgrades of the water distribution system.

When?

- We expect to start work on or about Thursday November 30, 2017.

Traffic and Parking Control

- We may need to reduce traffic to a single lane during construction.
- If we have to reroute traffic, we will place signs giving directions.

Driveway Access

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- We will make sure businesses have access at all times.
- Please call the Project Manager if you have special needs related to access or business hours.

Replacing and Taking Care of Your Sod

- We will place topsoil and sod in disturbed areas from the watermain upgrades based upon availability. Areas which settle over the winter months will be filled in with new topsoil next spring, 2018.
- The contractor will take care of any sod we replace for 30 days
- You can help the sod to stay healthy by watering it for one hour in the early morning, two or three times a week. This is especially important in hot or dry weather.

Repairing Your Driveway

- If we have marked or cut your driveway, we will repair the asphalt in the disturbed area as marked on your driveway. Unfortunately, the Region **cannot** completely replace your driveway.
- **Given the season and weather, the Region will temporarily restore the immediately disturbed areas of your driveway. This asphalt shall be removed and disposed of when permanent driveway restoration is complete in the spring of 2018. Completing the permanent restoration during favorable weather shall allow for optimal conditions for a quality finish.**
- We will repair your driveway as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.
- **If you are planning or like to have the rest of your driveway paved, you are encouraged to wait until the spring of 2018 in order to avoid any cuts or patches that may be required on your driveway during the work.**
- **Please contact either the contractor or the paving subcontractor named on the front of this letter. These are the only two contacts for you. Please do not accept direct solicitation from any contractor telling you that they have been retained by the Region. Please remember this is your option. If you choose to do nothing, we will repair all areas damaged by our construction; however, we are unable to completely replace your driveway.**

Repairing the Road, Curb, and Sidewalks

- All sections of curbs and sidewalks impacted by watermain construction shall be replaced on Camberley Crescent.
- The impacted roadway on Camberley Crescent will be restored with new asphalt over the watermain trench width only.

Project Updates

- The Region of Peel will always let you know if there are any major changes to the plans.
- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
- Please call the project manager or inspector if you have any problems or special needs.
