**CITY OF BRAMPTON**

**SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION ON GOREWAY DRIVE AND HUMBERWEST PARKWAY**

**Starting January 19, 2018**

**What are we doing?**

- Temporarily reducing the posted speed limit from 70 km/h to **50 km/h** during watermain and sanitary sewer construction on Goreway Drive and Humberwest Parkway.
- The temporary speed limit reduction will include both northbound and southbound traffic on Goreway Drive and Humberwest Parkway from Steeles Avenue East to Exchange Drive.
- Reducing the posted speed limit promotes worker and motorist safety for vehicles travelling through dedicated construction zones and traffic control measures.
- Once construction is complete, the posted speed limit will be reinstated to 70 km/h.

**Motorists**

- Please obey all posted traffic signs and the instructions of Paid Duty Police Officers when present.
- Lane reductions and major traffic delays can be expected. Please plan ahead or use an alternate route.
- Access to connecting side streets and driveways of businesses will remain open.
