**PROJECT UPDATE  
JACKSON ROAD AND JUNIPER CRESCENT  
CITY OF BRAMPTON**

**What are we doing?**

- Reinstating driveways, sod and curbs following the replacement of the watermain and services along Juniper Crescent and Jackson Road.
- Paving of both Juniper Crescent and Jackson Road.
- Complete restoration following upgrade of the water distribution system.

**When?**

- Work on curbs, sidewalks, road and boulevard is expected to start the week of May 20<sup>th</sup>. As work depends on the weather, these dates may change.

**Traffic and Parking Control**

- Please make sure that the road is cleared of vehicles (and any type of materials) by 7a.m.
- We may need to reduce traffic to a single lane during construction.
- **Please do not park on the road during the paving works.**

**Driveway Access**

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- We will make sure you have access at all times.
- Please call the Project Manager if you have special needs related to access or business hours.

**Replacing and Taking Care of Your Sod**

- The contractor will take care of any sod we replace for 30 days.
- You can help the sod to stay healthy by watering it for one hour in the early morning, two or three times a week. This is especially important in hot or dry weather.
- We will replace your sod as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.

- It is very common for the work area to settle a bit following construction. If you notice any settlement, please let the project manager or inspector know and we will ensure the contractor fixes it.

### **Repairing Your Driveway**

- If we have cut your driveway and you live on Jackson Road, we will repair the asphalt in the disturbed area from edge to edge across. Unfortunately, the Region **cannot** completely replace your driveway. **Please review the marks on your driveway.**
- If we have cut your driveway and you live on Juniper Crescent, we will repair the asphalt in the disturbed area as marked on your driveway. Unfortunately, the Region **cannot** completely replace your driveway. **Please review the marks on your driveway.**
- We will repair your driveway as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.
- **Driveways on Juniper Crescent impacted by watermain construction will be restored to property line as part of the City of Brampton's road resurfacing program, anticipated in 2020/2021, subject to budget and Council approval. If you are planning to have your driveway paved, you are encouraged to wait until the City of Brampton's road resurfacing program commences in order to avoid any cuts or patches that may be required on your driveway during the work.**
- **If you live on Jackson Road and you would like to have the rest of your driveway paved at this time, please contact the contractor named on the front of this letter. The contractor will then refer you to the subcontractor being used for this project. Please do not accept direct solicitation from any contractor telling you that they have been retained by the Region. Please remember this is your option. If you choose to do nothing, we will repair all areas damaged by our construction; however, we are unable to completely replace your driveway.**

### **Repairing the Road, Curb, and Sidewalks**

- All sections of curbs and sidewalks impacted by watermain construction shall be replaced on both Jackson Road and Juniper Crescent.
- The impacted roadway on Juniper Crescent will be temporarily restored with new asphalt over the **watermain trench width only.**
- One full lane will be permanently restored on Jackson Road on the watermain side.
- As part of the overall improvement on Juniper Crescent, the City of Brampton shall resurface the street as part of their road resurfacing program, which will include replacement of deficient curb and sidewalk. Road resurfacing is anticipated in 2020/2021, subject to budget and Council approval; this will allow the Region of Peel's warranty to expire on the watermain works.

### **Project Updates**

- The Region of Peel will always let you know if there are any major changes to the plans.
- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
- Please call the project manager or inspector if you have any problems or special needs.
