**WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF MISSISSAUGA ROAD
CITY OF BRAMPTON
PROJECTS 02-4090, 06-4025 and 12-4040**

PROJECT NOTICE UPDATE:

The Region's contractor has been working through winter on the watermain and the culvert structures and continues to make good progress.

Lane Closures and Restrictions

Lane closures on Mississauga Road and lane restrictions on Bovaird Drive will be required during the next phase of construction to complete the culvert and commence roadworks:

- **Mississauga Road - Left turn lane closures** are scheduled between April 16th and May 29th, 2018, weather permitting. The contractor will be working diligently to minimize the duration of the closure. Every effort will be made to keep through traffic lanes open
- **Bovaird Road - Lane restrictions/shifting of traffic lanes** to accommodate works on the culvert, beginning in mid-April and continuing until the culvert and subsequent roadworks are completed, which is anticipated to be in early August. Every effort will be made to keep the left turn lanes and through traffic lanes open.

The Region of Peel will keep you informed of any further substantial changes in the project scope or schedule.

What are we doing?

- Reconstruction and widening of the intersection of Mississauga Road and Bovaird Drive.
- Removing and replacing two (2) culverts
- Installation of a 1200mm and a 900mm watermain and valve chamber
- Construction of a geotextile reinforced retaining wall along Huttonville Creek
- Installation of an enhanced storm system (Low Impact Design) along the east side of Mississauga Road, south of Bovaird Drive
- Installation of landscaping along Mississauga Road and along Huttonville Creek
- Installation of enhanced swales along the west side of Mississauga Road, south of Bovaird Drive.

Where?

- Approximately 300m north of Williams Parkway to approximately 330m north of Bovaird Drive and the widening and reconstruction of Bovaird Drive from 300m west of Mississauga Road to 530m east of Mississauga Road.

When?

- Start: **June, 2016**
- Finish: **August, 2018, weather permitting**
