Motorists

- Pedestrian Sidewalk on the south side of Bovaird Drive between Ashby Field Drive and Worthington Avenue/Lake Louis Drive will be temporarily closed, and the north multi-use pathway will be opened.
- Brampton Transit bus stops will be temporarily relocated near-by when working in the immediate area.
- Please obey sidewalk closure signs and follow posted transit signs to the nearest relocated stop.

- The Region of Peel is widening and improving Bovaird Drive West from Creditview Road to Worthington Avenue, including new multi-use pathways and replacement of the westbound CN Rail bridge.
