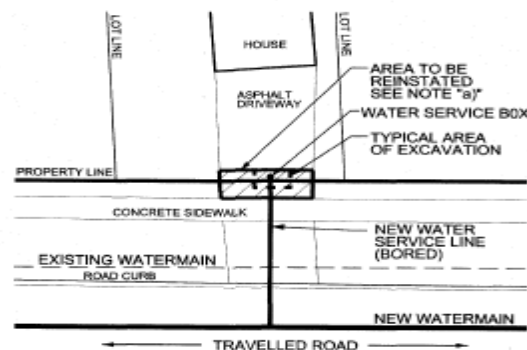

**PROJECT UPDATE
WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT
HAROLD STREET, WATSON CRESCENT AND PARKEND AVENUE
CITY OF BRAMPTON**

What has been done?

- We have completed the final restoration on the upgrades done to your water distribution system related to the above referenced project (18-1340H) with the exception of a small portion of the project area on Harold Street at Woodview Park.
- There is another Regional project (11-2371) occurring on Harold at Woodview Park. Therefore, at this time we have temporarily reinstated the road, driveways, and curb in this area.
- Final restoration of the area adjacent to Woodview Park at Harold Street will be done after completion of project 11-2371 in late Spring/early Summer of 2020.
- As mentioned in previous notices, permanent driveway restoration and road resurfacing on Harold will be performed as part of the City of Brampton's road resurfacing project anticipated in 2021 (subject to budget and Council approval).
- Permanent driveway restoration will be done as per the picture below. Unfortunately, the Region or the City **cannot** completely replace your driveway.
