**PROJECT UPDATE
WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT
HAROLD STREET, WATSON CRESCENT AND PARKEND AVENUE
CITY OF BRAMPTON**

What has been done?

- To complete restoration following the upgrades done to your water distribution system we have temporarily reinstated driveways, sod, and curb following the replacement of the watermain and services along Watson Crescent and Parkend Avenue.
- Final sod restoration is in progress at some locations.

What will be done?

- We expect to start road restoration (paving) work of the watermain trench on or about July 15, 2019 on Watson Crescent. We then will proceed to Parkend Avenue.
- Before paving on Parkend, we will be completing a final watermain connection at the west end of Parkend Avenue. We will also be switching out the recently installed steel air vent pipes to a residentially aesthetic air vent.
- As part of the overall improvement on Harold, Watson Crescent and Parkend Avenue, the City of Brampton shall resurface your street as part of their road resurfacing program. Road resurfacing is anticipated in 2021, subject to budget and Council approval.
- The project should be completed by September 31, 2019 (inclusive of Parkend, Watson, and Harold).

Traffic and Parking Control

- We may need to reduce traffic to a single lane during construction.
- If we have to reroute traffic, we will place signs giving directions.

Driveway Access

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- We will make sure businesses have access at all times.
- Please call the Project Manager if you have special needs related to access or business hours.

Replacing and Taking Care of Your Sod

- The contractor will take care of any sod we replace for 30 days.
- You can help the sod to stay healthy by watering it for one hour in the early morning, two or three times a week. This is especially important in hot or dry weather.
- We will replace your sod as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.
- It is very common for the work area to settle a bit following construction. If you notice any settlement, please let the project manager or inspector know and we will ensure the contractor fixes it.

Repairing Your Driveway

- If we have cut your driveway, we have temporarily repaired the asphalt. Your driveway will be restored permanently to property line as part of the City of Brampton's road resurfacing program, anticipated in 2021, subject to budget and Council approval.
- If you are planning to have your driveway paved, you are encouraged to wait until the City of Brampton's road resurfacing program commences in order to avoid any cuts or patches that may be required on your driveway during the work.
- We will repair your driveway as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.

Project Updates

- The Region of Peel will always let you know if there are any major changes to the plans.
- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
- Please call the project manager or inspector if you have any problems or special needs.
