PROJECT UPDATE

REHABILITATION OF ERIN MILLS PARKWAY FROM FOWLER DRIVE TO SOUTH OF HWY 403 CITY OF MISSISSAUGA, PROJECT 18-4635

What are we doing?

- Completion of phase 2 of the boulevard work includes:
 - placement of 2nd lift of hot mix asphalt on the multi-use trail
 - concrete sidewalk, and topsoil and restorations
- Completion of the bridge work includes:
 - parapet walls and guiderails
- Erin Mills Parkway road resurfacing work includes:
 - full depth asphalt removals, and placement of new hot mix asphalt

When?

- Construction is set to resume on Erin Mills Parkway in spring 2020, weather permitting.
- Final roadway restoration work should be completed by fall 2020.

Traffic Impacts?

- **Boulevard Works:** During peak traffic times, every effort will be made to maintain two or more lanes of traffic in either direction on Erin Mills Parkway
- **Milling and Paving Works (between intersections):** Milling and paving operations will be phased so as to minimize disruption to traffic. However, due to the nature of the works, lane closures will be required and left turning movements and intersections may be temporarily blocked while work progresses.
- **Milling and Paving Works (Intersections):** Milling and paving operations at the intersections may be carried out during weekends and nights to minimize traffic disturbances, as full road closures will be required for this work. Further updates will be provided 48 hours in advance of closures for each intersection.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

Working Hours?

- The Contractor's working hours are from 7:00AM to 7:00PM, Monday to Friday, with the exception of intersection work noted above.

Expect major delays, and please obey all traffic signs, paid duty police officers and flagpersons when present. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.
