



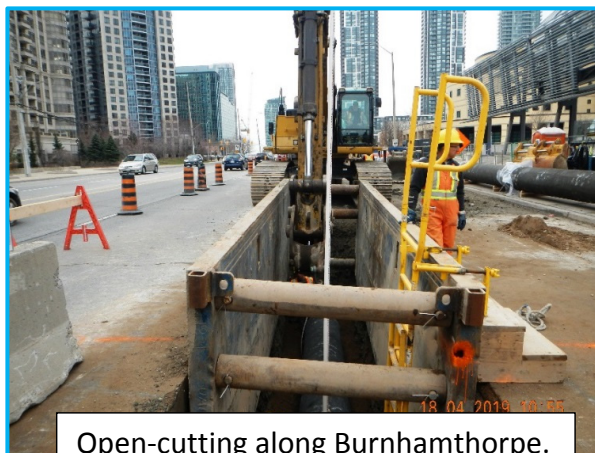

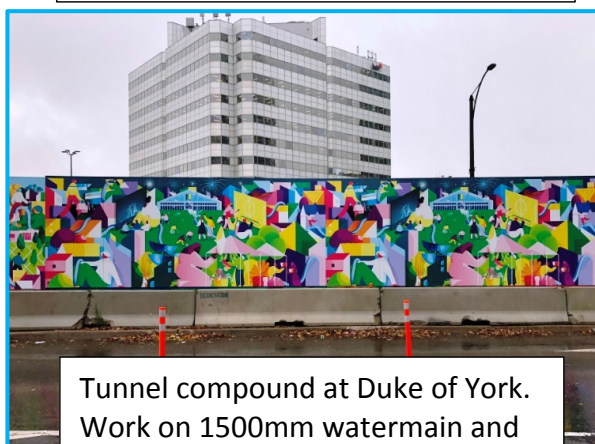

What's Happening by Celebration Square?

- We are installing a new 600mm (2 feet) diameter watermain by open-cutting along Burnhamthorpe Road between Hurontario Street and Grand Park Drive. **Westbound traffic lanes** along the route and the **parking bays** on Burnhamthorpe behind the Celebration Square stage will be impacted while we do the work.
- Work on the tunnelled 1500mm (5 feet) diameter watermain is confined to the compounds you see along Burnhamthorpe Road, such as the one at Duke of York Boulevard pictured here.
- **Future works** include installing:
 - 1200mm (4 feet) diameter sanitary sewer by tunnelling under Duke of York Boulevard between Burnhamthorpe Road and north of Rathburn Road, and under Burnhamthorpe Road between Duke of York Boulevard and Hurontario Street;
 - 600mm (2 feet) diameter watermain by open-cutting Duke of York Boulevard between Burnhamthorpe Road and City Centre Drive;
 - 400mm (16 inch) diameter watermain across Duke of York Boulevard at City Centre Drive.



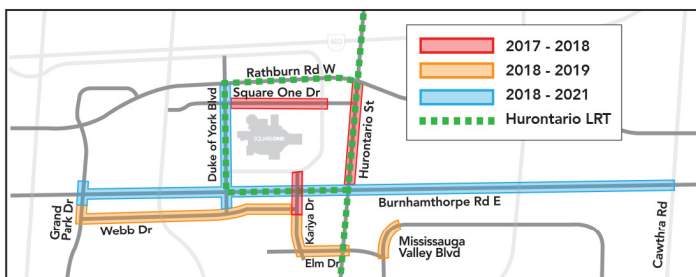
Open-cutting along Burnhamthorpe.
