

# **Environmental Assessment Study**

## **NOTICE OF ONLINE PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #1** McVean Sanitary Pumping Station Upgrades, 3900 Ebenezer Rd., Brampton

#### **The Study**

The Region of Peel has identified the need to upgrade and expand the capacity of the McVean Sanitary Pumping Station (SPS), in order to service planned growth within the City of Brampton, as well as to upgrade the SPS to comply with current Region design standards. These upgrades include odour control, grit management, emergency storage capacity, and additional site works necessary to facilitate the expansion and upgrades. As a result, a Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment (EA) has been initiated to identify a solution for this infrastructure need. The map below shows the area that may be directly impacted by the proposed construction.


### The Study Process will include:

- Public and stakeholder consultations;
- An evaluation of alternative solutions;
- An assessment of proposed alternatives; and, ٠
- Identification of methods to lessen the adverse ٠ impacts to the community.
