
### Notice of Completion – Review Period to July 19, 2019 Schedule B - Front Street Pumping Station Wastewater Diversion Project

#### The Study

The Region of Peel has identified the need to address the current Front Street Pumping Station catchment area wastewater flows to align with the Region's long-term sustainable plan to provide wastewater services.

The preferred solution includes:

- Constructing a new gravity sewer along Lakeshore Road and Pine Avenue South
- Constructing a new wastewater pumping station in Richard's Memorial Park
- Decommissioning of the current Front Street wastewater pumping station located in the Port Credit Lighthouse and
- Decommissioning of the Ben Machree wastewater pumping station

If concerns arise regarding this project, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the Region of Peel, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks to order a change in the project status and require a higher level of assessment under an Environmental Assessment process (referred to as a Part II Order). Reasons must be provided for the request and must be received by the Minister within 30 calendar days of this notice. A Part II Order Request Form is available online on the Forms Repository website ([www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca](http://www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca)) by searching "Part II Order" or "012-2206E". If there is no request received by **July 19, 2019**, the Region of Peel will proceed with design and construction of the pumping stations and decommissioning of the old pumping stations, as presented in the planning documentation.
