Notice of Public Information Centres Front Street Station Wastewater Diversion Project

Study Background

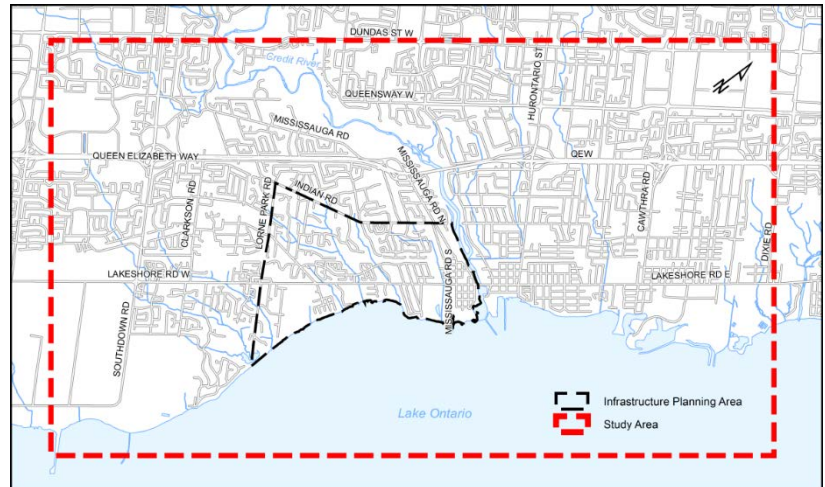
The Region of Peel has identified the need to address the existing Front Street Station catchment area wastewater flows to align with the Region's long-term sustainable plan to provide wastewater services. As a result a Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment (EA) has been initiated to identify a solution for this infrastructure need. Some or all of the solutions being evaluated will involve construction along Lakeshore Road.

The Study Process

The map shows the study and infrastructure planning areas.

The EA process includes:

- Public and stakeholder meetings
- An evaluation of alternative solution
- An impact assessment of proposed alternatives
- Selection of a preferred solution
- Identification of methods to lessen the impacts to the community



Public Information Centres (PICs)

As a part of this study, two Public Information Centres (PICs) will be held to present study findings to the public and other stakeholders, and to provide an opportunity to provide comments and feedback to the project team.

PIC 1 will introduce the background and objectives of the study, the approach to the evaluating the alternatives, present the list of alternatives, and to ask for public input.
