

How to Drive in a Roundabout

Approaching the Roundabout

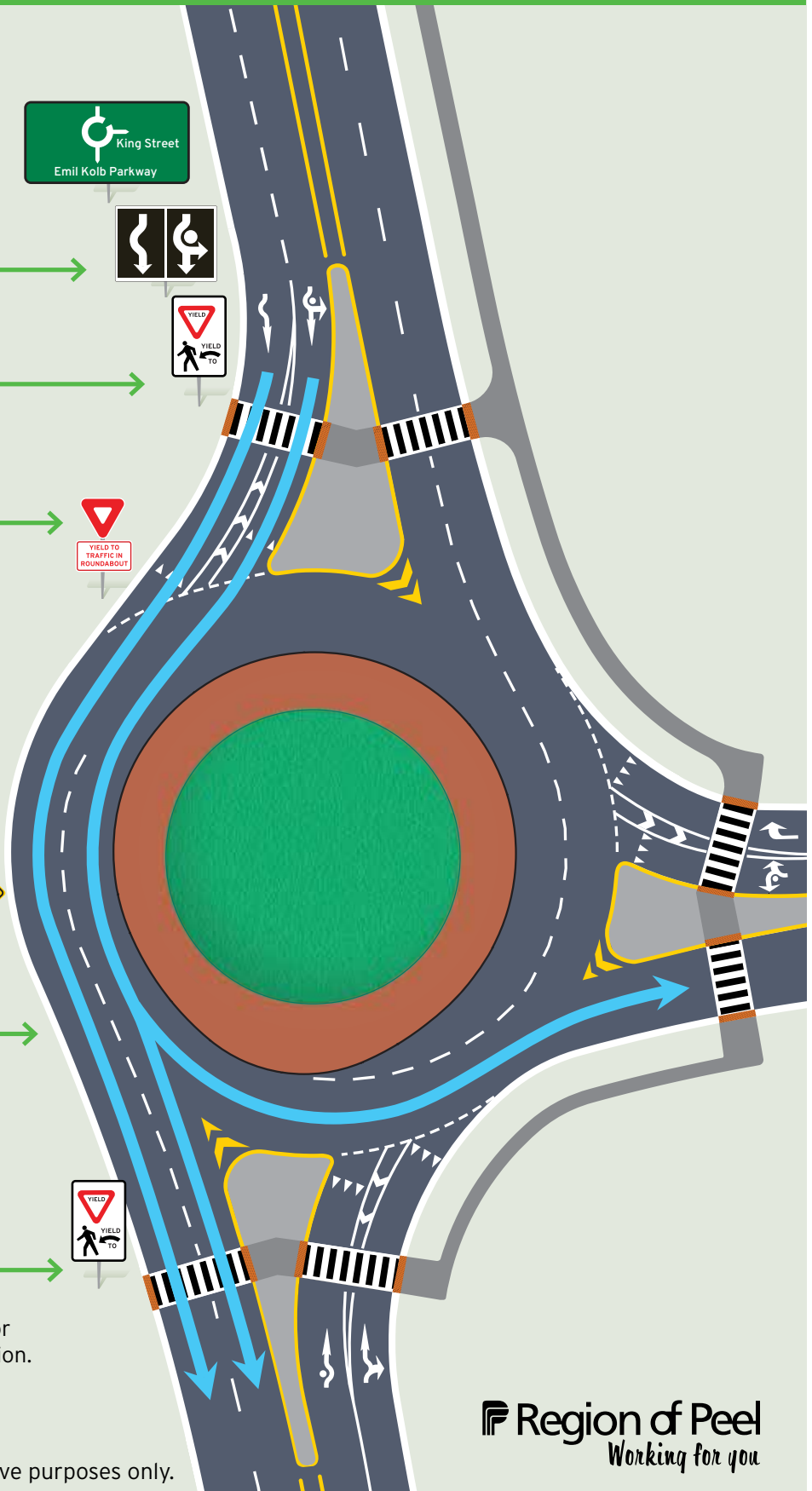
1. Slow down and choose your route. →
- ! 2. Choose the correct lane for your route and follow through. →
3. Yield to pedestrians. →
- ! 4. Yield to traffic in ALL lanes of the roundabout on entry. Traffic in the roundabout has the right-of-way. →

Within the Roundabout

- ! 5. Do not pass or drive next to vehicles within a roundabout.
Large trucks should straddle both lanes when using the roundabout.
Give large vehicles room and do not drive next to them. →
6. Do not change lanes inside a roundabout. →

Exiting the Roundabout

7. Signal as you exit and remember to yield to pedestrians. →
- ! Important: This is a common driving error in a roundabout that may lead to a collision.
