Purpose	The purpose of this document is to communicate the Service Manager's local rule for the minimum number of buildings an applicant must select when waiting for rent-geared-to-income (RGI) subsidy on the centralized wait list (CWL).

Peel's Policy	Effective August 01, 2017, the Service Manager implemented a local rule whereby applicants on the CWL will be required to select a minimum of five (5) buildings and must maintain that minimum selection. This is also applicable after a refusal of an offer.	
	Failure to Select a Minimum of Five (5) Buildings	
	If an applicant has not selected a minimum of five (5) buildings, PATH will require an update to the building selections.	

If the applicant fails to expand their selections and/or provide a Building Selection Sheet (BSS) with a minimum of five (5) applicable selections within 30 days from the date requested, then they will be deemed by PATH to have selected all the buildings in the Region of Peel with units of the appropriate size.

Exemptions

PATH reserves the right to deem an applicant eligible for an exemption from selecting a minimum of five (5) buildings. It is a requirement to provide PATH with applicable documents i.e. medical forms, court documents and other valid verifications to support the exemption when requested.
