

Preventing rats where you live



Remove food and water supply

- ❑ Don't leave food out for an extended period, inside your home or around your property.
- ❑ Store food correctly inside your home, using tightly sealed containers.
- ❑ Clean and sanitize all garbage containers, recycling, and green bins regularly.
- ❑ When disposing of your garbage, never leave bags or waste on the ground and keep waste bin lids closed.
- ❑ Always pick up pet waste and dispose of it. Pet waste can be a nutritious source of food for rats and will attract them to revisit.
- ❑ Do not feed wildlife.



Remove points of entry and shelter

- ❑ Look for gaps around pipes, walls, floors or below doors the size of a quarter or larger.
- ❑ Keep your unit and property tidy and free from clutter.
- ❑ Help keep common areas clean and litter free.



What do I do if I see rats?

- ❑ If you see rats or evidence of rats within, or on the property, notify your Condominium Board, Property Manager or Superintendent.
