

Small Drinking Water System Convictions

Peel Public Health inspects small drinking water systems for compliance with the Small Drinking Water Systems Regulation (Reg. 319/08) and the Health Protection and Promotion Act, 1990. If a person fails to comply with the legislation, a charge may be laid by a public health inspector.

Below is a list of premises where an offence occurred under the legislation and the owner or operator was charged and convicted. Convictions will be posted for two years from the conviction date. This list was last updated on **September 30, 2024**.
