Key Messages:

- The paid vaccine and STI medication delivery schedule is now available for January to June 2025.
- The RSV vaccine Abrysvo[™] is available to order.
- Ontario's publicly funded pneumococcal vaccine program transitioned to Pneu-C-15 (Vaxneuvance) and Pneu-C-20 (Prevnar 20).
- Please ensure that the appropriate pneumococcal vaccine product is being ordered and administered.

NEW: January to June 2025 paid vaccine and STI

medication delivery schedule

The paid vaccine and STI medication delivery schedule is available for January to June 2025. Ensure that your staff is on-site between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on your designated delivery date to receive orders.

NOTE: Orders need to be submitted 5 business days before the scheduled delivery date. Orders submitted after this date will be available for pick-up instead.

RSV vaccine supply update: Abrysvo™

Peel Public Health was provided with additional doses of Abrysvo™ that can be ordered through the <u>Health</u> <u>Professional's Portal.</u>

Eligibility

Individuals ≥60 years of age in the following populations:

- long-term care homes (LTCH), elder care lodges, or retirement homes (RH) residents
- hospitalized patients receiving alternate level care (ALC) including similar settings (e.g. complex continuing care, transitional programs)
- hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis patients
- solid organ or hematopoietic stem cell transplants recipients

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- people experiencing homelessness

In pregnancy:

- 32 to 36 weeks gestational age whose infant will be born just before or during the RSV season.

REMINDER: Pneumococcal vaccine product change

Ontario's publicly funded pneumococcal vaccine program transitioned to two new vaccines: Pneu-C-15 and Pneu-C-20. This change was announced in the July 22, 2024, Health Professional Update.

Please ensure that the appropriate pneumococcal vaccine product is ordered and administered as per eligibility criteria based on the patient's age and risk factors, as outlined in the accompanying tables.

NOTE: Re-vaccination is not part of the product change. Vaccination is to be administered to those who have not previously received or completed a series of publicly funded pneumococcal vaccine(s) of Pneu-P-23 and/or Pneu-C-13.

****Note**: Post-Hematopoietic stem-cell transplant (HSCT) recipients may receive up to 4 doses of Pneu-C-20. No boosters.
