

Notification of Chickenpox (Varicella) in Schools and Child Care Centres

Principals and child care centre operators are required to report cases of Communicable Diseases to the Health Department (*Health Protection and Promotion Act*). If you suspect a child has a communicable disease that requires an immediate response from public health call 905-799-7700. This will enable Peel Public Health staff to begin immediate investigation, or advise you if further action is required. Common childhood illnesses such as Pink eye, Hand Foot and Mouth Disease or Molluscum are not reportable to Public Health.
