The EYCC Service System Plan

Peel Region is a growing and diverse municipality, and the needs of its children and families have changed over the past 20 years. To help manage this growing system, Peel Region introduced a road map for early years and child care (EYCC System Plan 2025-2030).

It is our vision for creating a system that is affordable, diverse, inclusive, high quality, accountable, and accessible.



The EYCC System



Early Years and Child Care Services builds and supports a system that is responsive to current and future needs of children and families in Peel.

Licensed Child Care: we support child care providers to deliver inclusive, affordable, accountable, high quality and accessible child care.

EarlyON Program: we oversee free programs that help families with children 6 years and younger to grow and learn together.

Child Care Subsidy: we provide money and support so that families with lower incomes can afford licensed child care.

Special Needs Resourcing: we support all children to participate in licensed child care by connecting providers and families with special needs resources.
